Admissions requirements

- For admission into the two-year Master's programme at Agro ParisTech, Arts et Métiers ParisTech, Chimie ParisTech, Ecole des Ponts ParisTech, ENSAE ParisTech, ENSTA ParisTech, ESPCI ParisTech, Institut d'Optique *Graduate School*, MINES Paristech, Telecom ParisTech, you are required to have successfully completed at least 7 semesters of a Bachelor's degree in Science or Engineering at your home university by September 2011.
- For admission into the three-year Master's programme at Ecole Polytechnique, you are required to have successfully completed 4 to 6 semesters of a Bachelor's degree in Science or Engineering at your home university by January 2011.

- All applications must be received no later than the date shown on the web site, generally around the beginning of October. Late applications will be rejected.
- Eligible applicants will be asked to take a written test in October 2010 and will be interviewed in China between the end of October and the end of November 2010 by ParisTech representatives (see website for more details).
- Final admission decisions will be announced by mid-December 2010.

Scholarships

Students admitted will benefit from a tuition waiver (up to \in 18,000 a year) for the duration of their stay at their host ParisTech School. Scolarships (of up to \in 15,000 a year) covering travel and living expenses may be awarded to outstanding applicants by the French or the Chinese authorities, by industrial sponsors and by the foundations of ParisTech schools.
